


STATEMENT BY RESIDENT ATTORNEYS



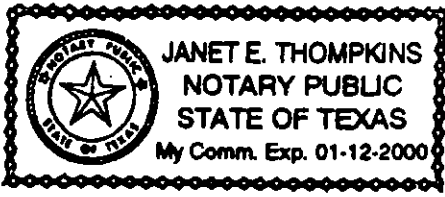


